Doing the Will of God

The famous American Archbishop and broadcaster, Fulton Sheen, once pointed out that the Creeds we use in Church make no mention of the life of Jesus. They refer to his birth "of the Virgin Mary" and in the very next line speak of his crucifixion. Why this lack of interest in the details of his life? After all, the Gospels are full of wonderful stories about the miracles he worked and the teachings he left us. Do they not deserve a mention in the great summaries of our faith? Apparently not. The explanation, Fulton Sheen says, is that Jesus did only one thing in his whole life and it is implicit in every line of the creed: he did the will of God. The conclusion we should draw from this, he suggests, is that the details of our own lives are of no great importance either, whether we are farmers, doctors, nurses, teachers, builders, priests, housewives etc. The only question of importance that will be put to us at the end of our lives is: did we do the will of God?
