Raising the Dead

The Gospels never stop telling us that all we need to be the object of Jesus' concern and love is to be 'dead'. In the stories of Jairus and the woman with the haemorrhage nobody has to prove themselves worthy; nobody has to do anything except cry out in the face of sickness and death. As writer Robert F. Capon put it: 'Jesus came to raise the dead. The only qualification for the gift of the Gospel is to be dead. You don't have to be smart. You don't have to be good. You don't have to be wise. You don't have to be wonderful. You don't have to be anything. You just have to be dead. That's it.' Jesus is like the mother who was hailed as a hero one night on television for raising a large family single-handedly in difficult circumstances. Asked by her interviewer, 'I suppose you loved all your children equally?', she replied: 'No, I didn't. I loved them all, but not equally. If one of them was hurting more than the others, I loved that one the most until they were better.'
