### Small Beginnings

A Dutch priest called Werenfried van Straaten wrote an article at Christmas 1947 highlighting the terrible conditions being endured by millions of German civilians displaced from the East at the end of World War II. Living in Belgium at the time, he appealed to Flemish farmers to donate food to the refugees. This earned him the nickname 'Bacon Priest'. It was the beginning of a charity called *Aid to the Church in Need*. Working initially in Eastern Europe, its mission expanded to support the struggling Church in Latin America, Africa and Asia. It now manages thousands of projects all over the world, working with refugees, training students for the priesthood, helping war-torn countries rebuild Churches, printing Bibles and providing religious programming on radio and television. Fr. van Straaten's basic philosophy was: 'People are better than you think; God too is better than you think.' In other words, from small beginnings miracles happen. The Eucharist is the most powerful expression of this. In it, we present to God the smallness of our lives and the ordinariness of bread and wine. As we give thanks, in memory of Christ, these gifts are changed, and we are made holy by the food of eternal life.
