## What God Has United

The American Rabbi, Harold Kushner, tells how a young couple came to see him one evening to arrange their wedding. The young man said to him: 'Rabbi, would you object if we made one small change to the vows. Instead of pronouncing us husband and wife "till death do us part", could you pronounce us husband and wife "for as long as love lasts?" We both feel that should the day come when we no longer love each other, it wouldn't be morally right for us to be stuck with each other.' But the rabbi replied: 'I do object, and I won't make the change. You and I know there is such a thing as divorce, and we know that a lot marriages don't last. But let me tell you something. If you go into marriage with an attitude of "If it doesn't work out, we can always split", I can almost guarantee that things won't work out for you. You must understand that a marriage commitment is not just a mutual willingness to live together but a commitment to accept the frustrations and disappointments that are an inevitable part of two imperfect human beings relating to each other. It's hard enough to make a go of marriage even when you give it everything you've got. But if only a part of you is involved in the relationship, then you have no chance.'
