In the early 1950s an undergraduate at Princeton University in New Jersey got a part-time job in the college library to help pay his tuition fees. One night at closing time he was going around advising people to finish their work when he came upon an old man furiously taking notes from a book. 'What course are you studying?' he asked sympathetically. 'Physics,' the old man replied. 'I did a physics course last year,' the student said. 'It wasn't too bad. You'll soon get the hang of it.' 'That's good to know,' said the old man, 'I like it but I don't find it easy.' A few minutes later he approached the desk to check out two books. The student took his library card, glanced at the name and almost collapsed in shock. The name on the card read 'Albert Einstein', the greatest physicist of the 20th century.

Like Peter in today's Gospel, Einstein understood that devotion to a cause is not a course we complete but a life-long surrender to a call that is greater than we can ever know. There is nothing more demanding and nothing that brings greater joy.
