Overcoming the Compulsion to React

Stephen Covey was one of the most influential educators and selfhelp gurus of our time. His most popular book is *The 7 Habits of* Highly Effective People. He describes how, after he had written it, he was browsing in a library one day and came upon three sentences in a book that 'staggered me to the core'. "Between stimulus and response there is a space. In that space lies our freedom and power to choose our response. In those choices lie our growth and our happiness." It led him to write another book, The 8th Habit: From Effectiveness to Greatness. His message is not merely that we should think before we act but that our ability to inhabit the space between what acts on us and how we act back is the beginning of spiritual growth. Jesus goes one step further. He says that this inner space is where we are unconditionally loved by God and we must learn to make it our home. Be compassionate as your Father is compassionate is not a piece of high-minded advice; it is the key to our happiness.
