The Greatest of These is Love

Viktor Frankl, a Jewish psychiatrist who survived the Nazi death camps, once said that there are three questions which can be answered correctly only by those who have reached moral adulthood. The first is: If I don't love you, who will give you the love I denied you? The second is: If I don't love you now, when can I give you the love I denied you now? The third is: If I do not love you or if I act lovingly towards you for totally selfish reasons, what am I?
