Moving the Comma

Maria Fyodorovna was the wife of Alexander III, Tsar of Russia from 1881 to 1894. His rule was marked by repression and, in particular, by persecution of the Jews. His wife, in contrast, was known for her generosity to those in need. On one occasion, her husband had signed an order consigning a prisoner to a life of exile and hard labour. The order read: 'Pardon impossible, to be sent to Siberia.' Maria saw the order on his desk and made a slight alteration. She moved the comma and changed the prisoner's life. The order now read: 'Pardon, impossible to be sent to Siberia.'

The story of the Prodigal Son shows that in Christ God has changed the comma that stood against us. Instead of 'Pardon impossible, to be condemned', it now reads 'Pardon, impossible to be condemned.'
