The Greatest Work of Art

An American student in Rome spent part of his summer holidays offering guided tours of St. Peter's Basilica to visitors from overseas. One day his group consisted entirely of Japanese tourists who were making their first visit to Western Europe. Sensing that they had little interest in the religious aspect of the tour, he spent most of his time pointing out the artistic achievements of Michelangelo and Bernini. The tour concluded at the gilded Baroque Chapel of the Blessed Sacrament. The student gave a very brief explanation of the purpose of the chapel but focused mainly on its artistic treasures. As the group dispersed, an elderly man who had been particularly attentive stayed behind and said, 'Excuse me, could you explain in more detail this "Blessed Sacrament"? I'm not sure I understood what you were saying.' Reluctantly, the student expanded on his original comments. The tourist's face became more animated as it changed from interest to wonder. 'But if what you say is true,' he said, 'what is in this chapel is a greater work of art than anything else in this Basilica.'
