Who is My Neighbour?

In June 2001, a young Palestinian man called Mazen Djulani died when he was shot in the head in East Jerusalem. His family immediately decided to donate his organs to a Jewish hospital. As a result, the lives of four Israeli citizens were saved. The dead man's father said he just wanted to save lives and live in peace with his Israeli neighbours. David Cohen, the father of the man who had received Mazen's heart said he was overwhelmed by the generosity of the Djulani family. 'It is really touching,' he said, 'especially in these days when relations are so tense. This noble family comes and teaches us that it is possible to do things in a different way.' Most of the Jewish media chose to ignore the story; Palestinian leaders complained that Israeli police harassed mourners at Mazen's funeral. In one sense, then, nothing changed: the violence and hatred continued. But four families learned to look at their neighbours in a different light and one family discovered the joy of being free.
