## Peace, Joy and the Glory of God

Between 1935 and 1939 the French horticulturalist, Francis Meilland, developed a rose that made him world-famous. The cultivar has large flowers of a light yellow to cream colour, slightly flushed at the petal edges with crimson-pink. In the summer of 1939 Meilland wondered whether his new rose could survive a European war in an occupied France so he sent cuttings to friends in Italy, Turkey, Germany and the United States. With no communication between the growers, the rose was given different names in different countries. In Italy it was called *Gioia*, the Italian word for 'joy'; in Germany it became known as *Gloria Dei*, Latin for 'glory of God'; and in America, Sweden and Norway it was named 'peace'. On the day that Berlin fell, the American growers publicly announced the production of the Peace Rose. It was given to each of the delegations at the inaugural meeting of the United Nations in San Francisco in 1945, with a note that read, 'We hope that the Peace Rose will influence men's thoughts for everlasting world peace'. In 1976 it was selected as the world's favourite rose.

*The good news was first sent out like Meilland's cuttings, into a troubled world, with little prospect of success. Its message was 'Peace'. It brought joy to those who heard it and those who preached it. In time, it conquered the world to the glory of God.*
