The Homage of the Humble

One man who took Jesus seriously was Mahatma Gandhi. Gandhi acknowledged that he had been greatly influenced by the Gospels and touched by the life of Christ. As he once remarked, 'I might have become a Christian had it not been for Christians!' Gandhi did not lead his people by standing like a king above them but by identifying with them and sharing their circumstances. When his legal adviser suggested that he wear a proper suit of clothes like other leaders, he said he wanted to dress like his people in loin cloth and cotton shawl. While the other high caste Indian politicians were not willing to associate with the untouchables, Gandhi chose to live, eat and march with them. He also gave them a new name, Harijans, 'the people of God'. On one occasion when he went to meet the King of England dressed in his loin cloth, a reporter asked him if he felt under-dressed. Gandhi replied, 'The King wears enough clothes for both of us.'
