Henry Ford, head of the Ford Motor Company, once visited his ancestral home in Co. Cork. Knowing his reputation as a great philanthropist, two trustees of a local hospital paid him a visit and asked him if he would like to make a donation. Delighted with this opportunity to help a worthy cause in his father's birthplace, Henry wrote them a cheque for five thousand dollars. The following day a local newspaper had a banner headline that read '**Henry Ford donates \$50,000 to Cork Hospital**'.
