Where are You?

Once there was an encounter between a jailed rabbi and his chief jailer. The deep piety of the rabbi touched the jailer deeply. A thoughtful person himself, the jailer began talking with his prisoner and questioning him on various points of Scripture. He asked the rabbi, 'How are we to understand that God, the all-knowing, had to say to Adam in the garden, "Where are you?"' The rabbi replied, 'Tell me, do you believe that the Scriptures are eternal and that every era, every generation, and every person is included in them?' 'Yes, I believe this,' said the jailer. 'Well then,' said the rabbi, 'in every era, God calls to everyone "Where are you? Where are you in your world?" So many years and days of those allotted to you have passed, and how far have you got in your world? God, for example, says something like this, "You have lived 46 years. How far along are you?"' When the chief jailer heard his age mentioned, his heart trembled.

Today's Gospel is asking us 'Where are you? Are you like the rich man? Do you really need a terrible disaster to finally see? Lazarus is at the gate. Can you see him?'
