The Cross and the Contact Lens

A young woman called Brenda Foltz describes an incident that happened to her while rock climbing with a group of friends. Halfway up the granite cliff, she came to a ledge and stopped for a breather. I can't eat it and it's awfully heavy. But if this is what you want me to do, I'll carry it for you.
