Mission: Impossible?

An international oil company sent a team to China to help develop the oil industry there. The team found it very difficult to cope with the challenges of their new environment. In addition to the language difficulties, they had trouble adjusting to the local culture and struggled to get to grips with the needs and demands of their workforce. After a while someone suggested they contact an American lay missionary who lived locally and was very popular with the natives, Christian and non-Christian alike. He might be able to advise them. The director invited him to a meeting and was so impressed by his knowledge and his character that he promptly offered him a senior position in the company. The missionary said no, so the director offered to double the salary. When he turned this down as well, the director asked him how much he was looking for. 'You don't understand,' said the missionary, 'it's not the salary. It's the job. In comparison with what I'm doing, it's too small.'

Today we celebrate and support all those who have chosen mission as their life's work: a huge job that yields riches that oil companies will always struggle to understand.
