Our Image of Others

The popular image of the Viking raider who plundered and pillaged Western Europe between the 8th and 11th centuries shows him wearing a massive horned helmet. Modern historians have established that this image is completely false. The Vikings may have worn leather or iron helmets but there isn't a shred of evidence to suggest that these helmets had horns on them. If they had appeared on these shores wearing helmets like that, not only would they have provoked laughter, they would also have been soundly defeated by the locals. The horns would get snagged on branches or embedded in shields, leaving them constantly vulnerable to counter-attack. So where did the image come from? Some people think that the medieval Church invented the horns to demonize them. This too is false. The truth is that 18th century artists created the image, probably basing themselves on Greek and Roman reports of Northern Europeans wearing horned helmets during ceremonial rites - long before the Vikings ever appeared.

The easiest thing in the world to have is a false impression of others.
