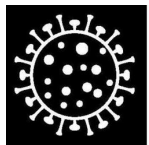

The American playwright and poet, Maya Angelou, remembers advice her grandmother gave her as a child. The old lady ran a store in a small town in Arkansas and had very decided views about some of her customers. Immediately the 'whiner' would start complaining about the weather. 'It's so hot out there and there's so much ploughing to be done. I'm sure the heat is affecting the machinery. The work is getting harder everyday etc.' Now and then, grandmother would throw an eye at Maya to see that she was taking all this in. When the grumbler had left, she would take the child aside and say, 'Child, there are people who went to sleep last night, black and white, rich and poor, who will never wake up again. Everyone of them would give up all they had for five minutes of this hot weather. Be careful about complaining. If you don't like something, change it. If you can't change it, change the way you think about it. But don't be a complainer because complaining will rob you of life.'

How to Prevent the Spread of Covid
