They Set off to Preach Repentance

A young priest was appointed as parish priest to a small, close-knit community. His predecessor, who had been there 20 years, was much loved in the parish. From the start the new man found it hard to win over his parishioners. One woman in particular made life difficult for him. She opposed his suggestions at meetings, rolled her eyes at his homilies and wouldn't speak to him at social gatherings. One day a letter addressed to her was delivered to him by mistake. It was marked urgent so he felt obliged to deliver it himself. When he arrived at her house, he took a deep breath before ringing the bell. Much to his relief there was no answer. He was about to drop the letter through the letter-box but felt courtesy demanded that he ring the bell a second time. This time he thought he heard a noise inside. The door, however, remained resolutely shut. He wondered if the woman had had an accident and needed help. He knelt down and looked through the keyhole. To his surprise he saw an eye looking back at him. Then he heard her chuckle and say, 'Well, Father, I think this is the first time you and I have seen eye to eye'. To which he replied, 'Yes, and we had to get down on our knees to do it!'

Repentance always requires us to get down on our knees and ask for God's help. Forgiveness is never effective unless the other person is on their knees too.
